1. Vote to approve the termination of an employee – Steph Wood

The information regarding the termination of an employee was received and approved by our legal counsel, Gary Anderson. Afterward, the Executive Committee met in an Executive Session and reviewed and discussed all of the information presented by Sarah Thurgood and Stephanie Wood. Our vote was unanimous. We are recommending the termination of an employee. When the need arises to terminate a staff member's employment, Bear River Head Start follows our employee policies, in particular the sections for "At-Will Employment" and "Involuntary Termination". The section regarding at-will employment and information on Involuntary Termination were sent out to Policy Council in the email about the interim meeting for tonight for review. The Employee Policies are reviewed annually and approved by Board and Policy Council as well as our legal counsel.

All terminations are taken before our legal counsel, Gary Anderson, an attorney at Hillyard,

Anderson & Olsen, P.C. Law Firm for review before the actual termination.

When there are concerns related to a staff member's behavior or conduct, their supervisor meets with them to discuss the concerns and to make a plan for improvement. Depending on the severity of the concern and other factors, a staff member may get a write-up about the concern or be immediately recommended for termination by their supervisor. If subsequent write-ups occur for the same or similar offenses, a request for termination is also made. Information related to the request for termination is presented to the Executive Committee (the elected Policy Council Officers) during an Executive Session. They vote to either recommend termination or not. An interim meeting is then scheduled and the vote goes before the entire Policy Council to vote to either approve the recommendation of termination made by the Executive Committee who had access to all of the documentation about the termination or to disapprove the recommendation of the Executive Committee.

The full details of this situation have not been shared with the entire Policy Council to maintain confidentiality and also protect the privacy of the staff member.

Policy Council was asked if they had any questions about this termination. No questions were asked.

We will go ahead and prepare the paperwork to go to an employee and will exit them. Thank you for your time tonight. We appreciate it.
